The Texas Open Records Act allows retired Police Officers, Firefighters, and Fire Inspectors to choose not to allow public access to their home addresses, home telephone numbers, Social Security numbers, or information that reveals whether they have family members.

If you do not complete and file this form, your information can be accessed by the public. Therefore, if you do not want such information about you released to the public, you should indicate your decision on this form to avoid any misinterpretation of your wishes.

If, at a later date, you decide to offer public access to your home address and telephone number, you must write the Dallas Police and Fire Pension System, 4100 Harry Hines Blvd., Suite 100, Dallas, Texas 75219, and tell us of the change.
