The Dallas Police and Fire Pension System, a dynamic, progressive public system, provides comprehensive retirement, death, and disability benefits for the City's 9,000 police officers, firefighters, pensioners, and their beneficiaries. Responsibilities:

Position reports to Administrator and the Investment Team and supports the overall management of investment strategies for a \$3 billion defined benefit plan. The portfolio is comprised of externally managed traditional funds and several separately managed investment accounts. Investments range from core to opportunistic. Duties include external manager oversight, manager searches, performance and financial analysis, and contract negotiation.

Requirements:

- Five or more years of experience in institutional investment management;
- Working knowledge of institutional investment management practices and financial markets theory; and
- Experience with asset allocation decisions, manager selection and performance monitoring.
- Degree in business with emphasis in investments or real estate preferred.
- Non-smoker

Ideal candidate will have an MBA and/or CFA and work experience at a public or private pension fund or an endowment fund.
