and print the following information:

- Demographic Information (address, phone number, etc.)
- Year-To-Date totals of benefit payments
- Federal Tax Withholding
- Deductions
- Direct Deposit information
- Federal Tax Reporting Documents

In addition, participants in DROP can access DROP account balances and project future account balances.

First time users will click on a link that will guide them

through the process of setting up a user name and password to access their information.

There is an on-line "help" function with "easy-to-understand" menus which give outlined steps for accomplishing each task.

Security of your personal information is of prime importance to us. Our use of state-of-the art encryption technology ensures your privacy as you access and navigate this site.

We hope you will use and enjoy this service. This is only **Phase One**, so more functions and services will be added in the coming months.

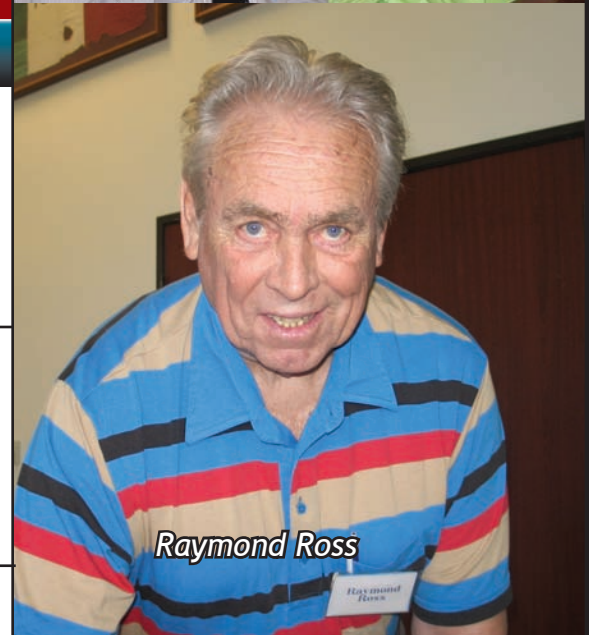

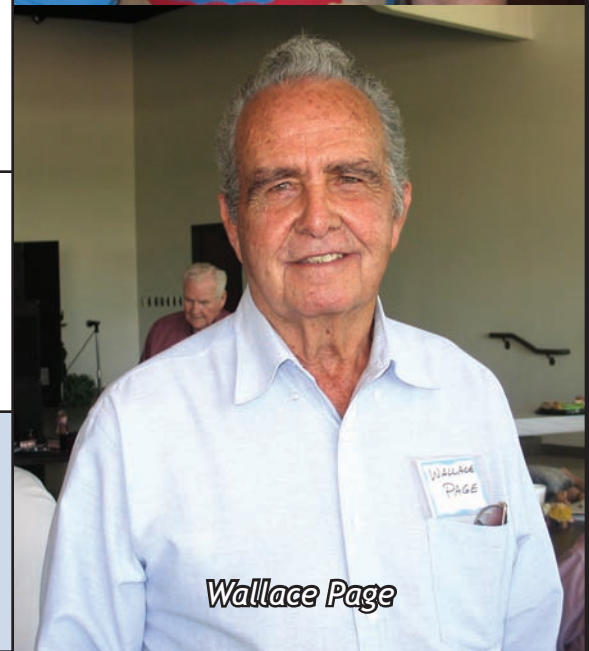

- are high in protein such as large amounts of meat.
- Wear lightweight, light colored clothing.
- Stay in air conditioned areas as much as possible. If air conditioning is not available, stay on the lowest floor out of the sunshine. Electric fans help evaporate perspiration, which will help cooling.
- Slow down; avoid heavy activity in the heat of the day if possible. This is usually between the hours of 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Avoid taking salt tablets unless directed to by your Doctor.

Remember to be safe, and be cool. Don't take a chance. If you become ill suddenly, call 911!
